Meeting started with Mark welcoming everyone & giving a quick review of the agenda

- A. Jerry Norberg – Fanny Lake LID Board member – Here to explain the ICOLA – Isanti County Coalition of Lake Association (?) Skogman Lake is the only big lake in the county not on this board. They formed to better communicate & cooperate with the county & DNR. Looking for a representative for Skogman Lake, \$50.00 annual fee (can be paid by our LID). ICOLA will present to the county on 9/5. They will meet on 8/22 at 3pm _____ (location?) Contact person is Jerry Norberg 763-689-3375.
- B. Meet new lake property owners: Brett & Tracy Slepica - Chris & Diana Gagnon
Thanking them for attending, giving them a quick explanation of LID vs Lake Association.
- C. Reviewed Brad Videens findings of his lake survey: “look at Brad’s notes) 1)no visible signs of Eurasian Milfoil 2) Curley-leaf pond weeds “brads notes” Shari says heavier on north east end 3) purple loosestrife - “Brad’s notes” (observation - added exploding along south end bay - other areas ??)
- D. Budget: \$13,412.00 on hand - paid \$4914.00 to Lake management for weed control - deposited last years grant \$850.00 - explained again, can only use LID funds for weed control in the lake -
- E. Reviewed board members: Mark Skoglund, John Cariveau (will be replaced by Steve Owens), Jenifer Hunt, Shari VanAlstine, Bill Berg, Grant Crocker, Brad Videen (Corky is this correct?) Mentioned if anyone is interested in the Lake Association they can contacted Kent Schutte (or) Shari VanAlstine - also Bill Berg has offered to share his beech for lake owners to sit and enjoy a band and other activities.
- F. Reviewed Lake Managements notes: 2017 – 33 property owners treated their individual shore lines for a total of 5.576 acres. 2018 – 29 property owners treated for a total of 5.028 acres. In 2018 that leaves _____ acres that were treated by Lake Management for a total of \$4,914.00.
- G. Voted on being a member of ICOLA. Steve Ownes motioned to be in the ICOLA, 12 people in attendance all voted, yes. Voted on the annual amount to be assessed. After some discussion Steve Owens motioned to keep at \$150.00 - 12 people in attendance voted, yes.
- H. Reviewed Board members again. Explaining must keep seven members on the board. Explained again why we formed the LID, to help control the spread of invasive weeds. Anyone interested in joining?? Can also contact any board member for more information.
- I. Any questions or comments? Security issues were brought up by one property owner. We discussed the advise of the officer we had in last year. Keep all buildings locked & report any suspicion activity. **Also would like to know what the DNR is surveying at the landing &**

what are the findings of the surveys? Follow up with the DNR & report back.
